



University Word Search

Find out the meanings of these words

Accommodation: A place that a large number of students live in during their time at university. A lot of students starting university move into 'halls of residence' where they have their own room and live alongside many other students.

Degree: A qualification awarded by a university. Different degrees have different names. For example, a Bachelor of Arts (BA) can be studied for courses like English, History, Politics, Fine Art and Teacher Education. A Bachelor of Science (BSc) can be studied for courses like Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Psychology and Nursing.

Exam: A formal test to determine a student's performance in different parts of their course. These might also take the form of coursework or practical demonstrations.

Freshers: Another name for students in their first year of university.

Graduation: A special ceremony that a student goes to at the end of their time at university to collect their degree.

Lecture: A type of lesson at university that can take place in front of 100 or more students in a large room called a lecture theatre. They are taught by a lecturer who usually teaches at the front of the lecture theatre, while students take notes.

Loan: Money that students use to pay for their studies and living costs while at university. A loan needs to be paid back once a student is earning a certain amount of money.

Module: A unit or section of a course that focuses on a really specific subject.

Placement: Work experience that students take while they study. Students have to take placements for more practical courses like nursing or teacher education, while other courses offer them optionally.

Semester: Another word for a term. Like at school, a lot of universities divide the year into three semesters - Christmas, Spring and Summer.

Society: A group or club at university where students come together with shared interests. Societies may focus on sports like football and cricket, but also other hobbies like movies and music.

Tutorial: A type of lesson with a small group of students and a lecturer to discuss a topic of the course or go into more detail about a lecture. Also known as Seminars.
